Drenthe University of Professional Education (Hogeschool) , was formed in 1987 as the result of an amalgamation of 5 institutions of higher education in the province of Drenthe. It is a government-funded institution. Moreover, some of the study programs are ranked No. 1 in the Netherlands.

Approximately 2400 students study at the Hogeschool and most students find it beneficial that the university is rather small. Personal attention, one of the most important characteristics within the institution, and the friendly and relaxed atmosphere provide the conditions in which all students enjoy the wide experience associated with university life while developing their talents to the full.
